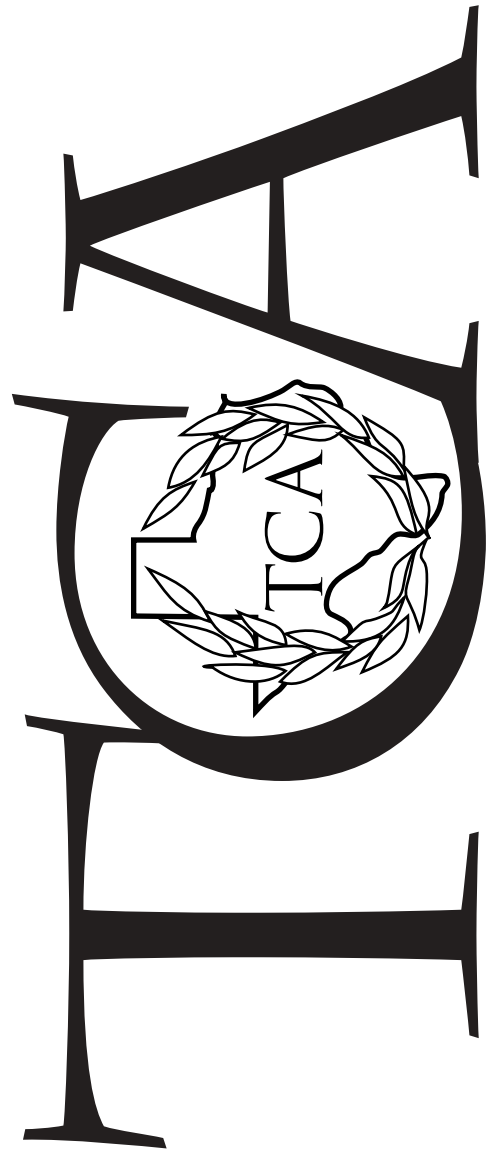

WHO · WE · ARE

The Texas Classical Association is an organization for teachers and future teachers of the classics in Texas at all levels, from the elementary school through the university.

The TCA annual meeting, held each fall, features papers and workshops on Latin pedagogy, Greek and Latin language and literature, ancient history, and archaeology, as well as a keynote address by a distinguished scholar and teacher.

The TCA is active in all areas of concern to teachers of Latin and the classics. Among the organization's current projects are promotion of oral Latin, evaluation of the Texas ExCET exam for Latin teachers, development of educational materials for collections of ancient art in Texas museums, placement and recruitment of Latin teachers, and advocacy of Latin at the local and state level.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the TCA includes eligibility for scholarships as well as two biannual publications. Each year the TCA awards one TCA Professional Scholarship of \$500 intended to support projects undertaken by members of the association, and two TCA Gareth Morgan Student Teacher Scholarships of \$250 for college seniors enrolled in a Latin certification program in Texas. In the fall, the TCA awards the Bertha Casey Scholarship of \$50

to a new teacher attending the TCA Fall Conference for the first time.

TCA's biannual journal, *Texas Classics in Action*, contains feature articles of interest to both high school teachers and professors, book and software reviews, pertinent reports that affect teaching the classics, plus a complete membership directory. The TCA also publishes a biannual newsletter with information about the annual conference in the fall and about scholarships in the spring.

The Texas Classical Association has its own website at www.txclassics.org. Through this electronic medium, the TCA has made available to its membership and others a variety of information that could not be distributed in a cost effective manner otherwise. "Mini" websites include the Unofficial Website for AP Latin, the Latin ExCET Prep website (for certification in Texas), Greek Too for those teaching Greek in the state, and a home page for CASUS (the Classical Association of the Southwestern United States).

Our website also features articles from the award-winning journal, *Texas Classics in Action*, links to sites of interest to Texas classicists, announcements, the TCA constitution, membership and subscription information, and a special page just for new teachers, plus a whole lot more.
